

## **Chase the Ace Raffle Rules and Regulations**

## **Prize Information:**

- The Accumulator will have a seeded prize of \$1,000 for the first series/game.
- Each week, 50% of sales for the event will be added to the accumulator unless the accumulator is won. If the card selected is the Ace of Spades, the participant will win the entire accumulator from the previously accumulated weeks.
- If the card selected is not the Ace of Spades, the participant will receive 10% of sales for the event as consolation prize and the accumulator will carry over to the next weekly draw.
- If a Joker is the card selected by the participant, an additional 10% of sales for that event will be the consolation prize.
- If the accumulator is won, then 50% of sales for that event will be the start of the new accumulator for the next series. If another series is not scheduled, then the 50% of sales for that event will be added to the current accumulator for the winner.

## **Ticket Information:**

- Ticket price(s): \$1 per ticket.
- A maximum of 50,000 tickets will be sold each week.
- Each participant may purchase up to \$100.00 of tickets per transaction at each event and additional ticket purchases are permitted after proceeding to the back of the line.
- Ticket purchasers must be 18 years of age or older.
- Must be present to win.
- All ticket sales are final. There will be no refunds issued to anyone for any reason
- Tickets are valid for each weekly draw only and are removed before the next weekly draw commences. To win the weekly and accumulator prize, the winner must have purchased the winning weekly ticket number.

#### **Event Information:**

- Tickets will be sold every Monday between 5:30 pm and 7:30 pm at Hotel La Broquerie
- Draw will take place every Monday at 8:00 pm at Hotel La Broquerie, until the Ace of Spades has been revealed thus concluding the game. A new series will start the following week unless otherwise advertised.
- 54 playing cards will be in each series of the deck, this includes two jokers

# **Draw Information:**

- The designated card that will win the accumulator is the Ace of Spades.
- Previously selected cards will be displayed on the Chase the Ace board, until the end of the series.
- An announcement will be made advising that the draw is taking place and a random person in attendance will draw the ticket.
- A single ticket will be drawn from all the tickets sold at the event and the number will be announced.
- The number will be called a minimum of three (3) times and the winning ticket holder will have five (5) minutes to present themselves. The winner must present the winning ticket to the caller before another ticket is drawn
- This process will continue until a winning ticket holder comes forward.
- Upon verification of the winner's ticket by the Raffle Chair or designate, the winner of the draw will place their ticket on the card they would like to select. The caller will confirm the card that the participant has chosen and reveal it to all in attendance.
- All cards drawn that are not the Ace of Spades will be signed and dated by the winner and posted in the venue after the event.
- All remaining cards will be used in the next event and secured in locked storage.
- When the Ace of Spades is drawn, La Broquerie Helping Hands has up to 48 hours to pay the winner.
- La Broquerie Helping Hands raffle chair is not allowed to participate.
- All persons who are involved with the running of that week's event are not eligible to participate.

## Other Information:

- Prior to the start of each draw, all cards in the current deck will be displayed on the table face-up in view of the participants. Cards must not overlap one another.
- All remaining cards must be shuffled and placed face down, with no cards overlapping another, on the same table before the participant chooses their card. The cards cannot be cut or handled by the player at any time.
- If any cards are discovered to have damage or markings, then the entire deck will be immediately replaced by a new deck of cards with previously chosen cards removed.
